The Benguet State University- College Qualifying Examination or BSU-CQE is the primary admission requirement to be admitted at the BSU. BSU offers courses in Agriculture, Agri-Business, Development Communication, Applied Statistics, Environmental Science, Information Technology, Agricultural Engineering, Forestry, Entrepreneurial Technology, Home Economics, Nutrition & Dietetics, Nursing, Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Library Information Science, Agricultural Education, and Veterinary Medicine.

Who may take the BSU-CQE

- Students who are currently enrolled in their Senior Year (4th Year) in any Dep. Ed recognized secondary school.
- Students who have graduated from high school but have not enrolled in any tertiary level school.

Requirements for the BSU-CQE

- Duly Accomplished Application Form (*may be obtained from the BSU- Office of Student Affairs, Office of the University Registrar or from the Information Desk, Administration Building or may be downloaded from www.bsu.edu.ph*)
- One (1) pc. ID picture (2x2 with white background)
- Receipt of testing fee (*from the BSU Cashier's Office, Administration Bldg*)
- Certificate of enrollment from the Principal for currently enrolled 4th year students.
- For those who graduated from high school but has not enrolled in any tertiary level school: Certified true photocopy of original High School Form 138 (Report Card)*

Application Period & Process

December 7, 2009- January 30, 2010. BSU- Office of Student Affairs (OSA), 2nd Floor, Student Center Building, Mondays-Fridays, 8:00am-5:30pm.
(NO LUNCH BREAK)

Group Filing: This is carried out with the help of the school guidance counselor or any High School representative.

- The guidance counselor, class adviser, or the school representative collects and checks that all the requirements including the Php 100.00 individual testing fee are in order.
- Proceed to the BSU- Cashiers' Office to pay for the testing fee.
- Proceed to the BSU-Office of Student Affairs and present receipt and all requirements for processing of papers.

Individual Filing:

- Applicant completes requirements.
- Proceed to the BSU-Cashier's Office to pay the Php. 100.00 Testing Fee.
- Proceed to the BSU-Office of Student Affairs, and present testing fee receipt with other requirements for processing.

NOTE: An applicant who has already taken the examination but did not enroll at BSU is advised to check with the Office of Student Affairs prior to his/her application. Examination Results are valid for 2 years.
