College Qualifying Examination 2nd Batch

The Benguet State University- College Qualifying Examination or BSU-CQE is the primary admission requirement to become a BSU student. BSU offers courses in Agriculture, Agri-Business, Development Communication, Applied Statistics, Environmental Science, Information Technology, Agricultural Engineering, Forestry, Entrepreneurial Technology, Home Economics, Nutrition & Dietetics, Nursing, Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Library Information Science, and Veterinary Medicine.

Who may take the BSU-CQE

- Students who are currently enrolled in their Senior Year (4th Year) in any Dep. Ed recognized secondary school.
- Students who have graduated from high school but have not enrolled in any tertiary level school
- Students who have NOT YET TAKEN previous BSU-CQE.
- Students who enrolled in a tertiary level school but wish to transfer to Benguet State University.

Requirements for the BSU-CQE

- Duly Accomplished Application Form (may be downloaded from www.bsu.edu.ph)
- Certified true copy or certified photocopy of the original High School Form 138 (Report Card)
[For Transferees: Submit a certified true copy of grades or a photocopy of your Official Transcript of Records]
- Certification of Good Moral Character from High School (recent and photocopied)
[For Transferees: Get your Certificate of Good Moral Character from the last school you have attended]

Application Period

February 2, 2009- March 13, 2009. BSU- Office of Student Affairs (OSA), 2nd Floor, Student Center Building, Mondays- Fridays, 8:00am-12:00nn, 1:00pm-5:00pm

Group Filing: This is carried out with the help of the school guidance counselor or any High School representative.

- The guidance counselor, class adviser, or the school representative collects all the requirements including the Php 100.00 individual Testing Fee
- Proceed to the BSU- Cashiers' Office to pay the total amount of Testing Fee.
- Proceed to the BSU-Office of Student Affairs and present receipt fee and all requirements for processing of papers.

Individual Filing:

- Applicant completes requirements 1-3
- Proceed to the BSU-Cashier's Office to pay the Php. 100.00 Testing Fee.
- Proceed to the BSU-Office of Student Affairs, and present testing fee receipt with the complete requirements for processing.
