## II. Students

#### A. Performance Licensure Examination

80% of examinees from BSU-Buguias campus passed the licensure examinations for teachers.

During the January 2022 Licensure Examination for Teachers, Buguias campus have six (6) passers out of eight (8) examinees for elementary level and five (5) out of 12 examinees passed the secondary level.

Meanwhile, one (1) of two (2) examinees passed the elementary level and three (3) out of 14 examinees of secondary level passed the March 2022 Licensure Examination for Teachers.

On the other hand, BSU- Buguias campus surpasses the national rate for the Agriculturist licensure examinations in which they have 66.67 % passing rate while half of the first timers passed the examinations.



32 out of 38 elementary teachers examinees (84.21 %) passed on October 2022 in which more than 80% of first timers passed. Meanwhile, 48 out of 51 examinees passed in secondary level for October 2022 LET in which more than of first timers passed.

#### **B. Enrollment**

For second semester of school year 2021-2022, the total number of students enrolled is 376 of which majority are enrolled in undergraduate programs.

93 students enrolled during midyear of 2022 in which more than three fourth enrolled in baccalaureate degree program.

A total of 772 students enrolled in Buguias campus for the first semester of school year 2022-2023. There are 715 enrollees for undergraduate, 23 for master's degree, and seven (7) enrollees for doctorate degree programs.

167 students participated in four (4) different trainings/seminars/conferences.








Distribution by educational attainment of plantilla faculty members
