# **ANNUAL REPORT**

### I. Curriculum

### A. Degree Program and short courses

In La Trinidad campus, there were 34 undergraduate programs, 37 master's degree programs, eight (8) doctorate degree programs, four diploma and three certificate programs.

During the 201<sup>st</sup> regular Board of Regents held on July 19,2022. The proposed new degree program MS Nutrition and Dietetics and proposed enhancement of BS Hospitality Management, MS Forestry (major in Silviculture and Watershed Management), MS Physical Education, MA Technical Vocational Studies were approved. The renaming of Physical Education to Physical Activities towards Health and Fitness (PATHFIT) was approved by the Board of Regents also.

New degree programs namely BS History, BS Psychology and MS Nutrition and Dietetics and BS Criminology extension were first offered during the first semester SY 2022-2023.

#### **B.** Accreditation

On February 14-16, 2022, two undergraduate degree programs namely BS Entrepreneurship, B Library and Information Science and BS Information Technology were visited for accreditation. Meanwhile five graduate degree programs namely MA technology and Home Economics, MA Home Economics, MS Forestry, M Public Administration and MS Physical Education were also visited for accreditation.

BS Environmental Science was the only undergraduate degree programs visited for accreditation on February 16-18, 2022. On the same date, MA Applied Statistics, MA Mathematics, MA Physics, MS Biology, MA General Science and PhD Science Education- Biology were visited.

B Public Administration and BS Hospitality Management were accredited last September 12-16,2022.

A total of six (6) undergraduate degree programs, 10 masteral degree programs and one (1) doctorate undergone accreditation this 2022.

### **II. Students**

### A. Performance in Licensure Examination

Licensure examinations for teachers were held during the first quarter. Nurses and another teacher's licensure examination was held on the second quarter. Meanwhile, licensure examinations for foresters, agricultural engineering, guidance counselor and librarians were held on the third quarter. Foresters, Nurses, Agriculturist, Teachers and Nutrionist - Dietetians licensure examinations were all held on the fourth quarter of the year.


Overall, more than half of the examinees passed the licensure examinations. Also, 79 % of first timers passed the licensure examinations while almost all of the degree programs which have licensure examinations surpasses the national passing rate.

Benguet State University rank as Top 1 during the November Nursing Licensure Examination. 127 first time examinees all passed the licensure examinations garnering a 100 % passing rate.

### **B. Enrollment**

For second semester of school year 2021-2022, the total number of students is 9,857 of which 84.10% are enrolled in undergraduate programs (Table 2). More than 2% enrolled in masteral and less than 14% in doctorate.

The total number of students who enrolled for Mid-Year in is 2,214 of which 76.56% enrolled in undergraduate programs, 20.05 % enrolled in Master's degree and the remaining 3.39% enrolled in Doctorate.

A total of 12,893 enrolled in La Trinidad campus for the first semester of school year 2022-2023. BSU - La Trinidad registered 10,994 enrollees for undergraduate, 88 enrollees for Professional Education, 18 enrollees for diploma, 38 enrollees for certificate, 1,528 for master's degree, and 227 enrollees for doctorate degree programs.

### C. Graduation

There is a total of 1, 585 graduates in the three campuses for school year 2021-2022. La Trinidad Campus has the biggest number with 1,585 graduates where 1,471 are from the undergraduate degree programs, 45 from diploma/certificates, 54 from master's and 15 from the doctorate programs.

For midyear of 2022, there are 72 graduates for all the degree programs in which more than half of it is baccalaureate degree graduates.

There were 311 Latin awardees with La Trinidad having 265 Cum Laude and 29 and Magna Cum Laude.




