**(REPAIR OF THE ELEMENTARY LABORATORY SCHOOL – HOME ECONOMICS, AND  
HEALTH & SCIENCE BUILDING)**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Contract made and entered into this APR 11 2023 day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2023 by and between:

**BENGUET STATE UNIVERSITY**, a chartered public educational institution of higher learning, established and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines having office at La Trinidad, Benguet, herein referred to as **BSU** and represented by its President, **DR. FELIPE SALAING COMILA**;

And

**JULIUS D. ELIO**, doing business as “**RHINESTONE CONSTRUCTION**”, of legal age, Filipino citizen, with principal address at FD 073 Tebteb, Balili, La Trinidad, Benguet herein referred to as “**the Contractor**”.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, consonant to the provisions of R.A. 9184, the Benguet State University posted an Invitation to Submit Quotation for the project **RFQ 2023-104 Repair of the Laboratory School-Home Economics, and Health & Science Building** in the PHILGEPS, agency website and four (4) conspicuous places continuously for seven (7) days starting February 17, 2023;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the invitation, four (4) bidders got bidding documents, however only three (3) bidders namely: JSBAL Construction Services, Rhinestone Construction and Ybetag Construction submitted their quotations on the scheduled submission at 2:00 PM of February 24, 2023

**WHEREAS**, during the opening of bids, the legal, technical and financial requirements submitted by the bidders, Ybetag Construction was declared ineligible and Rhinestone Construction emerged to be the lowest calculated quotation and thus, subject of post qualification;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation, verification and ocular inspection of the legal, technical and financial requirements submitted and stated in its bidding documents, the bid of the herein CONTRACTOR was found to be compliant and responsive to the requirements of the project. Hence, on March 9, 2023 under BAC Resolution Number 2023-116, the Bids and Awards Committee declared the bid of Rhinestone Construction as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation (LCRQ) for the project;

**WHEREAS**, the amount of the contract is **TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED SIXTY EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY TWO PESOS AND 36/100 ONLY (PHP. 2,968,452.36)** vis-a-vis the Approved Budget of the Contract amounting to Php. 3,000,000.00 for the execution



and completion of such works and the remedying of any defects therein. The funding source of the contract is from the 2023 GAA MOOE;

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the mutual commitment herein set forth, both contracting parties hereto have voluntarily agreed to the following terms, conditions and stipulations:

1. That the Contract time will be for a period of **One Hundred Sixty (160)** calendar days; counted from the contractor's receipt of the Notice to Proceed;
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:
  - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
    - i. Drawings/ Plans;
    - ii. Specifications;
    - iii. Bill of Quantities;
    - iv. General and Special Conditions of Contract;
    - v. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any;
  - b. Winning bidder's bid/ quotation, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted. Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes and all other documents submitted, including corrections to the bid, if any;
  - c. Performance Security;
  - d. Notice of Award of Contract and Bidder's conforme thereto; and
  - e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that the additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
3. In case of doubt or conflict between or among the provisions of the Agreement including the stipulations in the foregoing documents, the CONTRACTOR shall refer the same in writing to the OWNER for clarification and guidance. The clarification or determination made by the OWNER shall be binding and conclusive upon the parties.
4. In consideration of the payments to be made by the University to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the University to execute and complete the works and remedy any defects therein in conformity with the provisions of this contract and of the Government Procurement Law in all respects.
5. The University hereby covenants to pay the contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the works and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum that may become payable under the provisions of this contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by this contract.
6. The Contactor shall maintain cleanliness at all times in the premises of the project and to comply with the existing ordinances, laws, rules and regulations on environmental sanitation during the period of construction.

7. Pursuant to RA 11313, the following shall likewise be complied with by the contractor:
- To provide BSU, through the Physical Plant Office AND security office, with a complete list** of all his/her/its workers and personnel with their respective complete addresses assigned in the construction/work site or university premises within 3 days from deployment;
  - Post a copy of RA 11313 and its summary in a language known to the workers, say in Filipino and/or Ilocano**, in the workers' quarters, in a conspicuous place in the construction site expressly informing them that sexual harassment such as cursing, wolf-whistling, catcalling, leering and intrusive gazing, taunting, pursing, unwanted invitations, sexist slurs, persistent unwanted comments on one's appearance, relentless requests for one's personal details such as name, contact and social media details or destination, the use of words, gestures or actions that ridicule on the basis of sex, gender or sexual orientation, identity and/or expression, the persistent telling of sexual jokes, use of sexual names, comments and demands are criminal offenses and are strictly prohibited;
  - Prior to deployment, **conduct an orientation** for all the workers deployed within the BSU premises expressly educating them of the prohibition of sexual harassment and that a violation thereof **will result to criminal prosecution**;
  - All workers shall be **provided by the contractor and be required to wear at all times identification cards** containing their picture and complete name which are visible within a range of 15 feet. It should also contain the signature of the head of the security services since the ID cards shall also serve as their gate pass in gaining access to the University compound;
  - In cases where workers will be living temporarily in the work site, the quarters shall be **fully partitioned** even with light materials such as but not limited to canvass, G.I sheets (**excluding see-through materials**) and completely secluded from classrooms or completely covered from public view;
  - Construction sites, as much as feasible, should be **covered from public view** at least 3 feet above eye level or at a height of at least 10 feet from the ground to minimize eye contact between workers and students or the public;
  - The contractor shall employ systematic means to **confine the activities** of the workers inside the covered or fenced construction site;
  - In no case shall consumption of alcoholic drinks or smoking or vaping be allowed inside the construction site;
  - Shall abide by the IATF and DPWH Safety Rules while the construction site is under or affected by a community quarantine due to COVID-19 Pandemic; and
  - Failure of the contractor to perform any of the foregoing duties may be a ground for suspension of works, termination of contract or imposition of liquidated damages without prejudice to the prosecution of the erring worker and the contractor under the provisions of RA 11313.
8. The parties herein may, in writing, agree to any revision, alteration or addition to the terms and conditions of this agreement, provided the same shall not be in violation of the Procurement Law or any law, rule or regulation governing contracts on government infrastructure.


