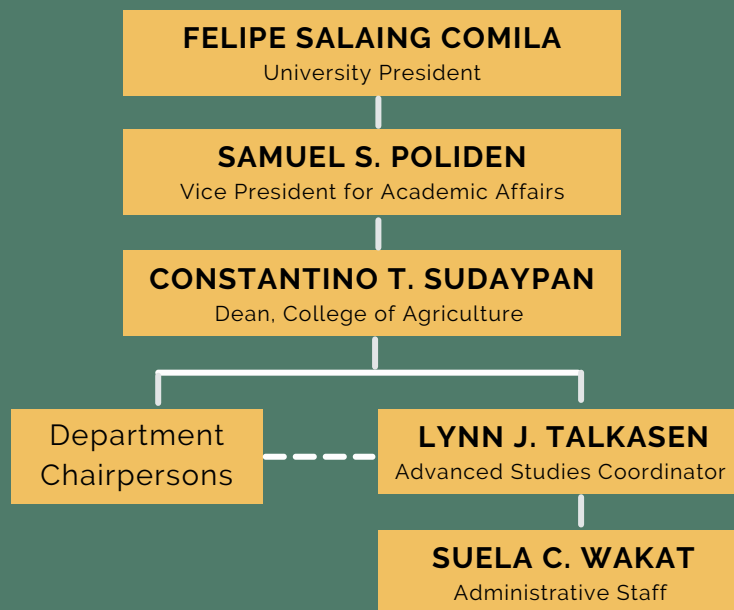

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Master's Program

1. Appropriate bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a university or from other recognized institutions of higher learning;
2. High academic standing; and,
3. English proficiency (for foreigner applicants)

Doctorate Program

- Appropriate master's degree or its equivalent from a university or other recognized educational institution;
- High academic standing;
- English proficiency for foreigner applicants); and,
- Have conducted a research study.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

For Filipino Citizens:

A duly accomplished Advanced Studies Application for Admission Form (BSU-CA-OAS Form 01), accompanied by:

1. Official Transcript of Records of undergraduate work (and graduate work, if any), for evaluation purposes:
 - Photocopies of records can be accepted provided they are properly authenticated.
 - For those who studied outside the Philippines, immediately preceding this application, scholastic record duly authenticated by the Philippine Foreign Service Post (PFSP) located in the student applicant's last educational institution attended (Red Ribbon Certificate)

Final admission will be subject to verification of documents submitted against original copies of credentials. Certified English translation should also be submitted where necessary;

2. Duly accomplished Recommendation Form (BSU-CA-OAS Form 02) from two (2) former professors with their evaluation of the applicant's potential for graduate work;
3. Certified Service Record or Certificate of employment for those who are employed.

For Foreign Nationals

(Additional documents):

1. A formal letter of application for admission, stating among others, the applicant's purpose in pursuing a graduate degree and specific field(s) of interest, including a personal history statement.
2. Certification of English language proficiency or TOEFL score of at least 500 words, or its equivalent, for applicants whose native language is not English, except those who are from institutions where the medium of instruction is English.

A non-refundable application fee of P100.00 (master's program) or P120.00 (doctorate program) for Filipino citizens, or USD 25 (or 1500 peso equivalent) for both master's and doctorate program for foreign nationals.

DEADLINE OF SUBMISSION

All applications must be received on or before:

- **June 30** for the first semester (August to December);
- **November 30** for the second semester (January to May); and
- **April 29** for Midyear term (June to July)
