Research and Extension Activities

A. Research Implemented

The University through the Research and Extension sector recorded 462 research projects/studies implemented for the year 2022. These projects are funded by the University and outside funding agencies. The implementation of these researches is in collaboration with the different colleges in the university, national line agencies and other stakeholders.

Of these 462 research projects/studies, 23 research programs/projects with a total budget of 111. 2 million pesos is being implemented by the different centers and colleges in the university. These researches are funded by DOST-PCAARRD, DA-BAR, CHED, Ministry of Science and Technology, Taiwan, Japan International Cooperation Agency Philippine Office (JICA-Philippines), and the DA Regional Field Office-CAR, Philex Mining Corporation and SRT La Trinidad Cooperative of Benguet.

D. Awards/Recognitions

The Benguet State University – School-on-Air (BSU-SoA) Teleradyo is recognized as the Most Development-Oriented AM Station by the Philippines Community Broadcasting Society (UP ComBroadSoc) during the 16th Gandingan Awards held via online on April 2, 2022. BSU-SoA won the General Award on Radio category through its entry titled Animal Welfare Act and Anti-Rabies. In addition, the BSU-on-the-Air segment which featured the topic on Organic Fertilizer was recognized as Best Agriculture Radio Program during the 15th Bright Leaf Agriculture Journalism Award held on September 13, 2022 .

Dr. Ruth C. Diego was awarded as Outstanding Extensionist during the 2022 Foundation Celebration of Benguet State University.

Dr. Roscinto Ian Lumbres, Director of the Center for Geoinformatics, is recognized as one of the 2022 Outstanding Young Scientist (OYS) in the field of Forestry Resources by the National Academy of Science and Technology (NAST). Dr. Lumbres was also awarded as Distinguished Alumnus in Research (Biodiversity and Carbon Stock Assessment) during the 2022 Foundation Celebration of Benguet State University September 29, 2022. He also received the 2022 Distinguished Alumnus Award for Special Achievement from the College of Forestry and Natural Resources of the University of the Philippines Los Baños on October 8, 2022. On the same date, Dr. Lumbres received the Special Achievement Award and 2022 CFNR Distinguished Alumni Awardee from the University of the Philippines Los Baños.

E. Intellectual Property Rights

The BSU Intellectual Property Right Office was able to apply for copyright 106 research and non-research-based creations/compositions in the form of instructional materials, manuals, books, journals and other creative works to the National Library of the Philippines.
