- A. The Benguet State University (BSU), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), is inviting registered Insurance Providers with valid licenses to submit a proposal on INSURANCE COVERAGE OF THE BSU STUDENTRY FROM SEPTEMBER 2022- AUGUST 2023 SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023: LA TRINIDAD CAMPUS, Undergraduate and Graduate Students
 - > 12,913 Students
- B. Insurance Providers shall have the following:
 - 1. Office branch established preferably within the vicinity of Baguio and Benguet Province.
 - 2. A 24-hour accessible hotline or assistance.
 - 3. Personnel available for the prosecution of the project must be specified.
- C. Guidelines:
 - a. The coverage of the insurance must be on a 24 hour per day basis for one year (2 full semesters) and that whether the insured student is at home, inside or outside the school premises, worldwide.
 b. The insurance should also cover injuries sustained while participating in activities such as but not limited to students who are attending intramurals, socio-cultural activities, sports and practicum or off campus activity.
 Note:
 - b.1. The insurance will still cover a BSU student who has paid the insurance fee even if his/her enrollment was withdrawn during the period SEPTEMBER 2022 TO AUGUST 2023, SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023
 - **b.2.** A BSU student who has graduated during the period January 2023 to July 2023 shall still be covered by the insurance.
 - 2. Processing/turnaround time of claims shall be within one month from date of submission of complete documents as per checklist of the insurer.
 - 3. List of documents needed when claiming should be included in the proposal.
 - 4. Payee should be the student.
